Lewis Parris Is Found Dead

Lewis (Buzz) Parris, 57, was found dead, a suicide, about 11 a.m. Saturday in his parked auto, less than amile from his home on Whitman drive, route 2.

A passing motoriest discovered the long-time Walla Walla resident and notified officers.

Coroner Leonard DeWitt said death apparently was due to carbon monoxide poisoning. A hose was attached to the rear of the auto releasing the gas into the interior.

DeWitt saie Parris left a note but the coroneer did not reveal its contents. When found parked near the Martin airport, Parris had been dead for several hours, officers said.

Born October 15, 1893 in Walla Walla, Parris attended Baker school and later was a student at St. martin's college near Olympia for three years, studying business and music.

A sports-minded man. Parris was well-known around Walla Walla as a baseball pitcher in the Twilight league.

Survivors include his widow, Ella Parris; two brothers, Charlie Parris and Thomas (Toots) Parris, both Walla Walla, and two sisters. Mrs. Alvin (Nena) Benedict and Mrs. Frank (Ruby) Ray, both Walla Walla.

The funeral will be at 3:30 p.m. Tuesday at a local mortuary, with interment in the family plot at Mt. View cemetery. He was a member of the lathers union.

Former Sheboygan Man Makes Headline On Western Coast

A name well-known to many of Sheboygan's old-timers made the headlines in the state of Washington recently when Ernst Bechly retired after 47 years as the Lewis County, Washington, engineer.

Ernst C. Bechly was born in Sheboygan on July 24, 1872, a son of this city's pioneer businessmen. His grandfather, Friederich Bechly, had brought his family to America in the late 1840's, and shortly after arriving in New York, the family made the trek to a little village on the shores of Lake Michigan in the new state of Wisconsin.

Grandfather Bechly established himself as a utler, a maker of knives, and soon became known as the "Tenacresmith" since he owned 10 acres of land and was a smith.

Ernst Bechly's father, Charles, didn't follow the trade of his fathers, and operated a cigar store on the corner of Eighth street and Pennsylvania avenue instead of making cutlery. Anson W.

Higby, 1508 Indiana avenue, who brought the above story to the attention of the Sheboygan Press, said he remembers well the huge cigar store Indian that used to stand glaring at all passersby in front of the Charles Bechly Cigar Store prior to the turn of the century.

The family left Sheboygan in 1891 because of the senior Bechly's health, and traveled by immigrant train through Canada to the state of Washington. They settled in Chehalis, Washington, where the family still lives.

Young Ernst Bechly was 19 years of age when the family moved to the West, and he went to work in a furniture company there for 75 cents per day. In 1903 he accepted a position with the county surveyor's office and he remained with the engineering department of Lewis county until his recent retirement.

In the history of the Bechly family, as related by Ernst Bechly to the Chehalis Advocate, Chahalis, Washington, the origin of the family name is established as being French. Mr. Higby stated that when the Bechly's lived in Sheboygan everyone thought it was a German name. The family had come to America from Uckermark, Germany, but according to the family history, the Bechly family originally lived in Ursebach, Switzerland, on the French border. At that time the name was spelled the same as it is today. It was in 169? that the Bechly clan moved to Germany due to a religious upheaval in their Swiss village. \*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*
